21 Day Fasting: The Source; The Richness; The Tips.

Fasts are corporate: as well as secret. Reflect on the "heart of Jesus' words" about fasting. Our motive is to encourage others, not only some hidden secret wish, to be seen "holy and spiritual." Uncover motives: ask, seek ways of encouragement needed by others, without clouding our hearts with pride (Matt. 6:16-18). Richness comes by combining Bible reading with prayer and fasting. God can increase "fire in our hearts" for His Word (Ps. 119). Be confident, specific, ask for clarity of vision from God. Record, so one can reflect on it at the end of 21 days.

Choose: a place, make a sacrifice, honor God. It will cost convenience, comfort, and take serious willpower. Sacrifices: food, phones, TV, games, media, internet; things we enjoy most. Be held accountable: God reveals to us what He wants us to sacrifice (1 Chronicles 21:18-26). Fasting: is not a hunger strike or discomfort to get God to do what we want. Use the experience to permanently alter how you see others, the needy, the lost. Pray: "God empty us." He will fill us with all of Him (Isaiah 56:6-8).

THINK IMAGE:

ENOCH a name pronounced E'nok): "A city built by (the first human born), Cain, after exile; has the same name as his son, Enoch. Used here the name refers to areas (Nod) outside of the "face of God." It means: lands of commotion, carnal disquietudes; where, trembling, dreaming wonderers, with unrighteous philosophies lived. Ironically, all lands outside of the "Garden of Eden" became lands of exile for the rest of humanity.

Seth, God's "replacement son" for Abel, is father of Enos (KJV); spelled Enosh/Enoch in scriptures, This Enoch is the grandson of Adam and Eve (Gen. 4:21). His name means "humanity." His period is identified as the time when people began to worship Yahweh (Gen. 5:6-11).

Enoch (seventh from Adam), Jared son's name, means "dedicated." This Enoch (not to be confused with Cain's or Seth's sons), lived in close relationship with God. This Enoch was translated into the presence of God without dying (Hebrews 11:5). Jude in verse 14 wrote: "he prophesized."

Extra-biblical literatures claim that Enoch's whole city was translated with him (Moses 7:23-64).

Ponder This Image: Enoch's city was filled with a mixed people, of one heart, one mind, united in belief; no poor among them. Can this be us?
