The **Power in Reading**: comes from the ability, capacity and freedom to do; instilled in us as we read scripture and pray for understanding. In reading we learn, that "God has all power!" This includes power to judge, forgive and power (Num. 14:15-19); to speak prophecy that **links** mankind to "the indwelling power of His Holy Spirit" (2 Kings). Here <u>power</u> equals His <u>Holy Ghost</u> [Helper] (Mic. 3:8; Luke 1:35).

What dose the Holy Spirit Helper teach? The "Helper," teaches us all things. He brings to us remembrance of all that Jesus said (John 14:26). Today, His teachings are seen in His written Word. As followers of Christ, we are learners. By carefully Reading (Luke 4:14; Acts 10:38) we learn the role of the Holy Ghost in empowering the ministry of Jesus and the church. (See: 1 Cor. 1:12-18; Rom. 1:16) and (1 Cor. 1:26-30; 2:3-4; 2 Cor. 12:9).

Jesus Gives Us Many Keys We can read (Matt , 16:19) how God holds the one Master Key, but gives many **keys** to His Son and Helper to distribute. They take by authority, what is God's and declare it to us. These keys are for opening the doors to heaven. Some keys are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude (courage), knowledge, and fear of the LORD (Isaiah II:2). Jesus by way of the "Spirit of Truth" speaks only correct things that lead to the kingdom of heaven. This is why it's so important to **read well**. Stumbling, mispronouncing words and inaccurate interpretation of what we read can be misleading or confusing. reading "give me a water bottle Example: when meaning to read, a bottle of water" will yield something not expected. The Son and Holy Ghost teaches truth with clarity. Learners are taught differently than deniers. Jesus' Parables were often unclear to unbelievers.

The Devil Has Keys: In reading (Rev 1:18) we learn his keys open doors to many knockoffs, They look good; are very appealing, but not lasting. In reading, Thank God, learners can see that the master key can open-up hell and shut/lock its doors, This is "POWER IN READING!"

KEYS TO THE KINGDOM!

KEYS: To the Kingdom of Heaven.

Key(s): In the Old Testament the word "key" is use in a singular tense. It's an opener (Judges 3:25): Reading Isaiah 22:22, we learn **this** key is an opener to the highest position. Only <u>one</u> under God's authority can use the key to open or close doors. It seems that our Father God has the **one** master key. The single word "key" only appears twice in the Old Testament representing usually 3 things: **Power, Authority or Ability.**

Power from the Holy Spirit is for us to do it ourselves or to delegate it. Authority can be delegated. Ability doesn't have to have authority. The relationship is the same with the four times mention in the New Testament (3 are in Revelations).

We **read to learn**, "who Jesus is." As learners of Jesus (disciples) we live <u>in</u> the world (in darkness) but <u>not of</u> the world (in light). Therefore we are His Word personified: "As the Father has sent me, so send I you." as light (salt [Matt. 5:14]) we give it to those walking in

darkness. How do we know when and what to do? By reading the Word of God (Matt 4:4). The Word is God and was manifested in Jesus. Therefore there is nothing that the Word of God can't conquer or bring to pass.

In the New Testament we **read** the word "keys" (Matt. 16:19) to learn how to discern, by power, what to loose, what to bind, and how to use the keys. We are taught that speaking the Word heals (Matt. 8:8) and can cast out spirits (Matt. 8:16). We understand that not conforming to the world is not just, "not doing what the world does" but is a total "renewing of mind" (2



Chron. 7:14). We are fellow citizens of the household of God, built upon the foundation of other learners (saints) with Jesus as the Chief Corner Stone. All together we are built for an habitation of God through the power of the Holy Spirit (Ep. 2:20-22).
