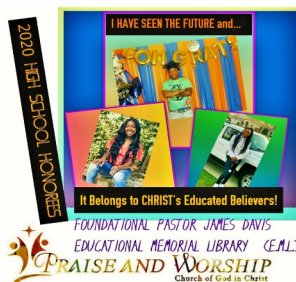

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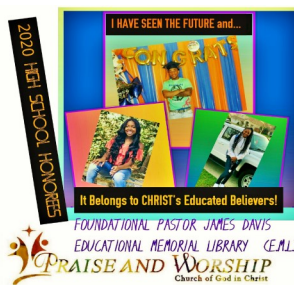

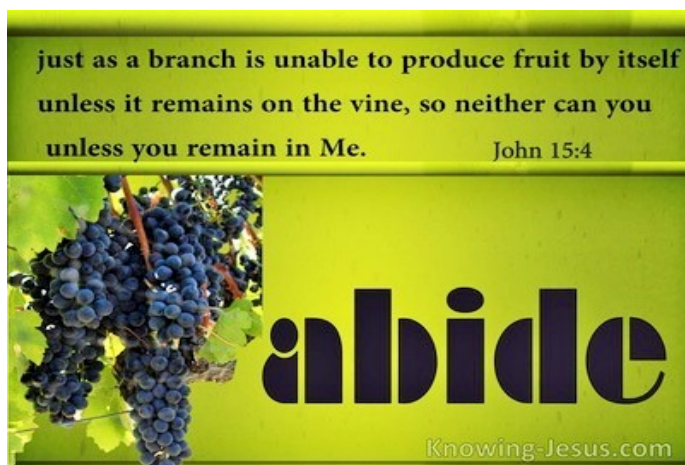

"FRUIT PRODUCING": The secret to fruit producing is as basic for us as it is for a real grapevine: stay attached to the Vine and focus all of our energy and attention to simply being there (In His Presence), or abiding (Holy Ghost filled), in Christ. Worship Him, praise Him, meditate on His words, seek solitude in Him, and let ourselves be absorbed into His purposes. God has made it very clear that Jesus is the Vine and we are the branches. Jesus abides in us, and we in Him bears much fruit; without Jesus we can do nothing ([C John 15:5](#)).

1). ON HOLY GROUND: has never been only within the temple building or church sanctuary. Our bodies are the temple of the Holy Ghost. It's seen in the way we live daily Holy lifestyles and about how we witness from the heart about our **Authority** (God) and our Authority's **Son** in our homes, communities, at college and as well as in our churches. If The Trinity Bundle is abiding in our hearts, we can be on Holy Ground anywhere. If we as branches are attached to the Vine, if Jesus is there inside and can be seen, we have the potential to produce precious fruit. Many of our sanctified heirs got saved and filled with the Holy Ghost at home! At the home altars they prayed, repented, God heard and were saved.

2). ABIDING IS LOVING: When we as branches are attached to Jesus, the Vine, God's love is abiding. Unlike God's love our love is conditional. We love others who loves and treat us with respect. If not, we often walk away from that relationship. We can't give love to others, if we haven't first receive it! ([C Ephesians 2:4-5](#)).

God's love is not like our love. God's love is unconditional! While we are living without Him in our lives, He'll come pruning, cultivating, and plowing to make us alive in Christ. God loves us first, He initiates a relationship with us while we are at our very worst. We can't earn or buy it. We already have His love. We must receive the Husbandman's unconditional love. Attachment to the Vine assures that the branches will become fruit producing.

3). ASK FOR ABIDING: Today in prayer we can ask God for help to receive love. We can ask Him to fill us with the confidence of knowing that we are loved and accepted by Him. Pray that He will give us a fresh revelation of the power of Jesus' cross. Help us to see ourselves as He sees us. In Jesus' name. RECEIVE IT! ([C Zephaniah 3:17; Psalms 136:26; Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:9-11](#)).
