

This year, James Davis E.M.L. DOOR POST Newsletters, are looking deeply into "HOLINESS!" January's issue set the pace with a "Holiness" overview. February's post examined holiness' gift of "SANCTIFICATION," In March we're inspired by "JUSTIFICATION." Continuing, in April's J.D.E.M.L. DOOR POST issue discusses "**PROPITIATION**!"

PROPITIATION: is the first gift of "holiness" used to remove God's Righteous Wrath. Sins of God's created are no small obstacle. Our righteous God cannot sweep our sins under the rug of the universe. Sins are the **acts** of **cosmic treason** <u>against</u> God! There must be "propitiation," the <u>appeasement</u> of His righteous anger against sin. **Jesus** is <u>the one</u> "whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God." (Romans 3:25).

GOD'S JUSTICE: Our God is just! He has a righteous anger, hatred, against sin. In **love** for His created, God devised a way to satisfy justice and still triumph with mercy. God himself, in the person of His own Son, took on human flesh and blood and offered Himself in the place of sinners. **JESUS**: the pure, sinless Son received the **just** wrath of our angry God and paid our whole <u>sin</u> penalty in His death, that we might live. The Son's blood propitiated/satisfied God's righteous wrath. It was propitiated blood that upheld divine justice, and opened to us — to all who receive this <u>appeasement</u> by faith — the floodgates of His mercy. [C Romans. 3].

GOD'S FORBEARANCE: had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished. "...*No one was righteous, not even one*." "...*none who understands*; ...*none who seeks after God*" (Romans 3:11 NKJV). It's made very clear by scripture that we're, every one of us, are in the same boat with everybody else, forced to face our complicity to sin. **BUT** propitiation made God's <u>mercy</u> available to us all.

WE ARE SAINTS: whose sins, in life are never too big for Christ to overcome! <u>But</u> it is our **choice** to be made "holy in <u>Christ</u>. It's wise to take time out from this world with all its enticements and pause, repent, separate and receive God's mercy. Our unfaithfulness does not nullify God's faithfulness. Not at all! God's revelations are true. How else can we be vindicated and overcome when we are judged. **God** <u>straightens</u> it all out right [<u>C Ps. 51:4</u>]. APRIL 2022

As Holy Holidays are celebrated, let's consider God's plan to satisfy His wrath against the penalty **demanded** by His good justice.

- **Propitiation**: is God's loving plan for sinless blood to free us from Satan's captivity. All were guilty! Sin's contamination had spread to God's created humans, animals, land and sea.
- pitiation is God's plan for Sinless Jesus canceled the debt that stood to convict us [C Col. 2:14].

is the process by which sins are nullified or covered for a time. It falls under the concept of propitiation. Explation without propitiation would make God indifferent to sin and unjust. Explation can only refer to the "sacrifice of atonement" by animal blood sprinkling at the **site/place** on the Day of Atonement, the Mercy Seat. This Hebrew "kaphar atonement" can only for a time quench God's wrath [C Num. 25:11-13].

THINK IMAGE:

PROPITIATION: speaks of the placation of an offended partyspecifically our God—from wrath or anger. Propitiation is the only way God could offer mercy and forgiveness to sinner and at the same time, be just [C Romans 3:26]. By this Propitiation the love of God was manifested [C 1 John 4:9-10].
