

The annual theme for James Davis's EML DOOR POST Newsletter in 2023 is **PURITY**! Each month we will plunge deeper into what the BIBLE teaches about this noun.

PURITY: While prime time American television promotes idolatry, fornication, adultery, same sex relationships and gay marriage, etc., as the norm, the **Bible** calls followers of Christ to live different from the world. True Believers are called to live lives that are holy. This calls for setting aside the evil ways of the world and honoring Christ by living in faithful obedience to His commandments. The Bible teaches, "As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy'" (1 Peter 1:14-16 NIV).

AUTHENTIC PURITY: True Bible Believers are tired of the smoke and mirrors of our society. Our now generation has a deep longing for authenticity. We pray for the fluff to go away. We pray for the real thing. Our "endtimes" generation values sincerity and authenticity. A recent survey showing that 67% of the members of our "end-times" generation agree that being true to one's values, morals and beliefs makes a person better. The word authentic is defined as being real, genuine, of undisputed origin, true, and original. Believers desire something that is real and pure. An authentic Believer is one who is inspired by God and who shows the love of Christ. It is someone who walks in faith, demonstrating the Father's heart, and being God's hands and feet.

GOD IS NOT CALLING US TO BE PERFECT: He needs us to be honest so He can continue to do <u>His work</u> in us to make us more like Him. Be **honest** with yourself so that God can transform your heart.

THE WORD OF GOD: encourages us to be believers who purify ourselves from everything that contaminates the body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God. Our prayers should be as David's, asking God to create in us a **pure** heart and a **renewed** steadfast spirit. [C Psalm 51]. We live in a polluted, filthy, corrupted world and need God's help to be authentic and pure. His Word washes us and cleans our hearts and minds.
