

CONTINUING: this year, to look **deeply** into "HOLINESS," James Davis' **July** E.M.L. DOOR POST Newsletter discusses "**SIN**!"

SIN: brings harm and is any action, or err by which humans rebel against God, miss His purpose for their life, and surrender to the power of evil rather than to God. It causes us to become enemies of God [C Rom. 5:10]. Jesus did not bear the cross, just to try to get His angry father to love us. He died to reunite humanity's estrangement from his Father. WHY? If we cherish sin in our heart, the Lord, will not listen to our prayers. Jesus obtains for us, salvation, to meet the demands of his Father's holiness. God will not reject our prayers or withhold His faithful love, grace, mercy, and loyal kindness from His children! [C Acts 9:17–19; C Gal. 6:1-2].

WHO WILL BE SPARED: "...the Spirit says to the churches. He who <u>overcomes</u> shall not be hurt by the second death" (Rev. 2:116 NAS). The second death is the "Lake of Fire," or "Hell!"

PERMISSION TO HATE SIN: God invented the idea of dealing with sin by putting it to death. God's Word [Jesus] indicates that dealing with **sin** is like a bloody battle—something has to die [C Col. 3:5; Rom.6:11-12]. Hating sin helps us deal a blow to corruption in our own lives. Romans 12:9 tells us to hate or "abhor what is evil." Hate is the precursor to hold fast to what is good." Without the hating of evil and sin, we diminish our ability to love. For us to "let love be genuine" (v. 9), we need to hate some things deeply.

DON'T WINK AT SIN! Instead of winking at sin, ignoring it, or dumbing it down, **hate** it. We don't like holding on to what we hate, so give it a go, and hate away.

BIBLICAL WEAPONS FOR HATING SIN! 1). Have a prayer talk with God. 2). Tell Him how much you hate sin and how it's affecting human life. 3). Make it personal: Say, "I hate sin, I need Your help to hate it even more." Wield these biblical weapons with spiritual enthusiasm, and watch the sin that has you by the throat today will be under God's foot tomorrow. [C 1 John 4:7-9; James 5:16; Psalm. 66:18-19].


